## ACTUAL x CURRENT

actual /'æk.tʃu.əl/ is an adjective which means 'real'.

actually /'æk.t[u.ə.li/ is an adverb which means 'in fact'

current /'knr.ənt/ is an adjective which means 'at the present time' or 'most recent'.

currently /'knr.ənt.li/ is an adverb which means 'right now'.

Museums often don't actually exhibit the actual artefacts and instead put copies on display. This is to make sure that the originals don't get damaged or stolen.
