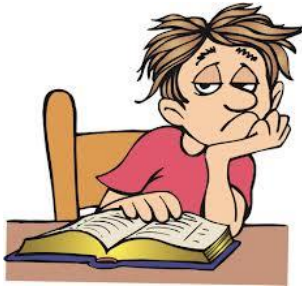
### BORED x BORING
