WAY TO DO



The expression "**way how**" is a perfect example of Czenglish and you can hear it practically everywhere – from university professors to absolute beginners. However, there is no such expression in English, they occur separately but not together.

"Way to" usually occurs in three situations: In case the manner is not specified, we can use **how + infinitive** or **the way + infinitive.** This is (how / the way) to do it.

If there are expressions such as **a**, **no**, **any**, **only**,

best, last etc. or numerals we use the form of **way(s) + infinitive or way(s) + of + gerund**; *Here are the ways to get / of getting there.*

When we speak about what a person does and how s/he does it, we can say, **the way + that + sentence or how + sentence or possessive pronoun + way(s) + of + gerund**; *I don't like the way (that) he does it / how he does it / his way of doing it.*
