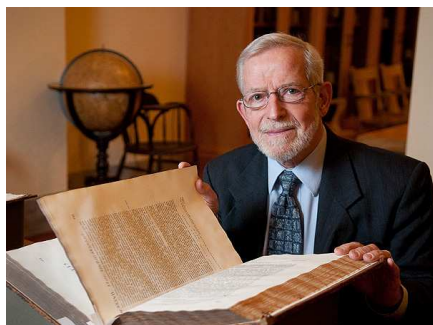

WAY TO DO



The expression "**way how**" is a perfect example of Czenglish and you can hear it practically everywhere – from university professors to absolute beginners. However, there is no such expression in English, they occur separately but not together.

"Way to" usually occurs in three situations:

In case the manner is not specified, we can use **how + infinitive** or **the way + infinitive**. *This is (how / the way) to do it.*

If there are expressions such as **a, no, any, only, best, last** etc. or numerals we use the form of **way(s) + infinitive** or **way(s) + of + gerund**; *Here are the ways to get / of getting there.*

When we speak about what a person does and how s/he does it, we can say, **the way + that + sentence** or **how + sentence** or **possessive pronoun + way(s) + of + gerund**; *I don't like the way (that) he does it / how he does it / his way of doing it.*

Bounce a check [baʊnts ə 'tʃek] – neproplatit, odmítnout proplatit šek

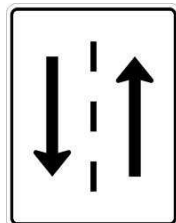
It will break the bank [ɪt wɪl 'breɪk ðə 'bæŋk] – to je náš konec, to nás zničí
