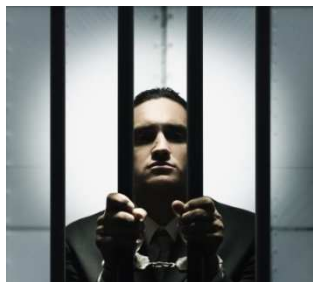


## CONFUSING CASES: AT or IN
