PRONUNCIATION vs. SPELLING: ALTHOUGH x THROUGH x TOUGH

Despite having identical spelling these three words differ greatly when you hear them:



Although [ɔːl'ðəʊ] as in flow, borrow, shadow

Through [θru:] as in flew, blue, threw

Tough [tʌf] as in stuff, buffalo, truffle
