CAREFUL OF, WITH or ABOUT never FOR

Don't say: Tomas is very careful for/with his health.

Say: Tomas is very **careful of/about** his health.

Or: You should be more **careful with** your money.



GIVING WARNINGS

There are a number of formulas used when Giving Warnings in English. Here are some of the most common:

- Don't push so hard on that toy, or you might / will break it!
- Watch out! Be careful!
- Study hard otherwise you'll fail your exam.

WARNING SIGNS

Keep out! – nevstupovat

Do not enter!/No admittance! – zákaz vstupu

Caution! Wet floors/Slippery surface. – Pozor! kluzký povrch

Parental guidance! – v doprovodu rodičů

Beware of the dog! – pozor na psa
