



HAVE GOT vs HAVE

HAVE GOT (Br. E.) vs. HAVE (Am. E.)

Don't say: "Sorry, we *haven't* this shirt in blue."

Say: "Sorry, we *don't have* this shirt in blue." (Am. E.)

We use **don't have/doesn't have** in negative sentences and **Do you/Does he have** in questions in Am. E. We use **haven't got/hasn't got** in negative sentences and **Have you/Has he got** in questions in Br. E.

AT THE CLOTHES SHOP SA: shop assistant (Am. E.) J: Jane (Br. E.)

J: Excuse me, I would like to try this cardigan on. Where is the **fitting room**, please?

SA: Over there around the corner.

(a little bit later) SA: Does it **fit**?

J: Yes, it fits but the color doesn't **suit** me. Have you got it in yellow?

SA: No, sorry. We don't **have** it **in stock** in this size. That's the last **piece**.

J: **That's a pity**. OK, I'll only take this **scarf**.

SA: All right. That's \$15, please. Do you have our **customer card**?

J: No, I haven't.

SA: Well, if you get a card, you can save 5% on all your **purchases**.

J: That sounds great! Can you **issue** it for me, please?

SA: Here you go. How would you like to pay?

J: By credit card, please. Thank you.
