

NO DOUBT & THERE IS NO DOUBT

Don't say: ~~No doubt the world is getting warmer.~~
Say: **There is no doubt** that the world is getting warmer.

No doubt means "probably" or "I suppose", not "certainly".
Cycling is certainly healthier than driving (NOT No doubt cycling is healthier than driving)



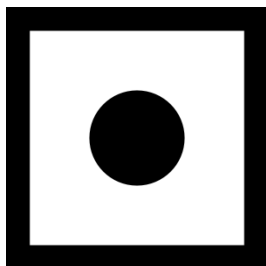
FOUR GOLDEN RULES OF FLYING
