TIME MANAGEMENT TIPS



- 1. Find out where you're wasting time: What are your time-bandits?
- **2. Use time management tools:** A software program such as Outlook, lets you <u>schedule</u> events easily and can be set to remind you of events in advance. Or use a <u>portable</u> version a diary with a daily planner.
- **3. Prioritize** <u>ruthlessly</u>: You should start each day with a session when you will prioritize the tasks for that day. Ask

yourself: How many of them do I truly need to accomplish today?

- **4. Learn to <u>delegate</u> and/or <u>outsource</u>:** No matter how small your business/household is, there's no need for you to have a one-person show.
- 5. Establish routines and stick to them as much as possible.
