Followed by an infinitive:

It's time to buy a new car. (Je načase koupit nové auto) It's time for her to go to bed.

Followed by past tense with present meaning:

It's high time she went to bed. (Je nejvyšší čas, aby šla do postele)

It's time you washed those trousers.

THE BUILDING BLOCKS OF A KICK-OFF MEETING

Getting to know everyone: who are we and how can we create a great team?



- 1. **Clarifying** the vision: what is the big picture, and what are we trying to do?
- 2. Communicating the goals and benefits: what, specifically, do we need to achieve?
- 3. Organizing the team and its **task**: how is the project structured, and who does what?
- 4. **Confirming budgets** and **resources**: how much can we spend, and how many people do we have?
- 5. **Developing a communication plan**: what do we need to say, to whom, by when and how?
