

ROAD X STREET X WAY

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road /r d/ is a noun meaning a route for traveling between places by vehicle. This is the part of the street where cars/trams/buses go.

street /stri t/ is a noun meaning the road between buildings in a city/town. A street usually has a sidewalk for people to walk on both sides of the road.

way /we / is a noun meaning a route, direction, or path.



GIVING DIRECTIONS



The **way** to the main train station from James Cook Languages is simple. You need to **go along** Na Florenci **street** until you reach Masarykovo Nádraží. You then **take two lefts** and **go down** Hybernova until you reach Opletalova. **Take a right** and go through the park to reach the main entrance to the station.
