

PRESENTATION SKILLS - STATISTICS

There were approximately 2,230,000 marriages in 2005 in the USA -- **down from** 2,279,000 the previous year, **despite** a total population **increase of** 2.9 million **over the same period**. The **divorce rate** in 2005 (per 1,000 people) was 3.6 - the **lowest rate since 1970**, and down from 4.2 in 2000 and from 4.7 in 1990. (The **peak** was at 5.3 in 1981, **according to** the *Associated Press*.)
