Don't say: I think that George will win the main price. **Say**: I think that George will win the main **prize**.

!The **price** is what you **pay if you buy** something. A **prize** is what you are given if you have done **something exceptional**, or if you **win a competition**.

THE NOBEL PRIZE



Every year since 1901 the Nobel Prize has been **awarded** for **achievements in** physics, chemistry, physiology or medicine, literature and for peace. The Nobel Prize is an international award **administered** by the Nobel Foundation in Stockholm, Sweden. In 1968, Sveriges Riksbank established The Sveriges Riksbank Prize in Economic Sciences, **in memory of** Alfred Nobel, **founder** of the

Nobel Prize. Each prize **consists of** a medal, personal diploma, and a cash award. The Nobel Prizes in the specific disciplines are **widely regarded as** the most prestigious award one can receive in those fields.
