

SMALL × SHORT × LOW

small /sm I/ is an adjective meaning little in size or amount than is average.

short / t/ is an <u>adjective</u> meaning small in length, distance, or height. A person that is not tall is short, not small!

low /l / is an adjective meaning less than usual or normal in size, number, amount, or value.
