

### **RECEIPT vs PRESCRIPTION**

Don't say: "Here is your receipt." Say: "Here is your prescription."

Receipt = a paper which is a confirmation that you payed for sth Prescription = a paper which doctor writes to patients to get some medicine



# AT THE DOCTOR'S D - doctor, P - patient, PH - pharmacist

D: Good morning, sir. Please have a seat there. What's the matter?

P: I've had a terrible **sore throat** and a bad **cough** for 3 days.

D: Do you have any other symptoms?

P: Yes, I had a **fever** last night. And right now I have a high temperature and I feel a bit **dizzy**.

D: Oh, I understand. Please take off your clothes to the **waist**. Taka a deep breath. I need to listen to your **lungs**.

D: Well, it isn't **pneumonia** but it looks like angina. I'll give you a prescription for antibiotics called Angina Plus. Take one **pill** every 8 hours.

P: OK, when shall I come for a check-up?

D: Come after you finish taking the antibiotics and we'll see. If you don't feel better, we will also have to **run a blood test** and will need a **urine sample**.

P: Thank you very much, doctor.



#### AT THE PHARMACY

P: I'd like one Angina Plus, please.

D: OK. Here you are and here is your receipt. It's 125, please.
