


TO x FOR

to and for are both prepositions. In general, we use to in front of a verb, and for in front of a noun. Reason with a noun: I came FOR dinner Reason with a verb: I came **TO** eat Here are a few more rules:

We go TO a destination	Benefits: something is good FOR somebody
We give things TO somebody	Helping: doing something FOR somebody


