In is used with **cities and countries**. We also say: in the country (side) and "in the city", *Living in the country is cheaper than living in a large city.*

In a number of **fixed expressions**: in the middle/ in the centre, in the queue/ in (the) line, in the sky, in the world,

in the picture / in the photograph

To talk about **areas of activity**: *He works in publishing.*

**ATM** – automated teller machine ['ɔ:tə,meɪtɪd 'telə mə'ʃi:n] – bankomat

**BIC** – bank identifier code ['bæŋk aɪ'dentɪfəɪə kəʊd] – kód banky

**CD** – certificate of deposit [sə'tɪfɪkət ɒv dɪ'pɒzɪt] – potvrzení vkladu

**EFT** – electronic funds transfer [ɪ,lek'trɒnɪk 'fʌndz træns.fɜ:] – převod

**IBAN** – international bank account number

[ɪntə'næʃənəl 'bæŋk ə'kaʊnt nʌmbə]

**ISF** – insufficient funds [ɪnsə'fɪʃənt fʌndz] – nedostatečné prostředky

**NSF** – non-sufficient funds [nɒn sə'fɪʃənt fʌndz] – nedostatečné prostředky

**PIN** – personal identity number ['pɜ:sənəl aɪ'dentɪtɪ nʌmbə]
