## Languages policy

**Target:** All employees with identified language development needs (CZ / EN / FR).

**Objectives:** To help employees to acquire and develop the language skills they need from business

point of view.

**Actions:** Employees are defaultly assigned for group sessions (with recommended amount of 3

students) using an external language school that is contracted with L'Oréal.

Exceptionally it is possible to arrange individual session for boosting language

competencies in a short time.

**Application:** • Courses are determined to employees with language level B1 at maximum.

- If foreign language is a must for daily job communication and the level of knowledge is insufficient L'Oréal covers the costs fully for those employees. For fully cost coverage by L'Oréal Divison Mancom Manager's approval is required.
- If foreign language is not a must for daily job communication L'Oréal covers the costs partially for those employees. In that cases employees can use EDENRED card for full (2 500 CZK) or partial (1 900 CZK) reimbursement twice per year (each July & January). Full reimbursement is applicable for individual language courses, partial reimbursement is applicable for group language courses. Applications need to be processed via the official document (Edenred reimbursement request) and submitted to Learning Manager.
- Individual courses are arranged for 20 lessons per semester whereas Group sessions are arranged for 25 lessons per semester. Each lesson is for 60 min, typically once per week.
- Each semester is for 5 months (summer semester: Feb-June & winter semester: Sep-Jan)
- You can transfer the remaining lessons from winter semester to summer semester if unspent. Such a transfer is not possible from summer semester to winter one so starting in Sep your remaining lessons will be annulled. You can intensify a frequency of the lessons during summer to use all lessons allocated.
- 70% attendance rate is a minimum requirement for students to complete a semester and to start another one.
- Time spent in language courses is not included to working hours of the employee.
   Courses must take place before 9.30am or after 4pm

Cancelation: •

- Students have to cancel their participation 24 hours latest prior the session via <u>SchoolPartner</u> system as per the instructions <u>here</u>. Those with <u>flexible schedules</u> communicate straight to their teacher.
- Monday lessons must be cancelled on Friday until 3pm the latest
- If the lesson is cancelled properly students are expected to reschedule it with the teacher (ideally during the same month)
- If the lesson is cancelled later it is considered as taught one and must be paid
